

Giving Evidence

In matters where you or your legal practitioner require Ms Bottomley to attend court either in person or via electronically to give evidence the following applies:

Fees to attend Court are \$6000 per day (or any part thereof) or \$3000 per half day (or any part thereof). If Ms Bottomley is cross examined electronically the cost is \$3000 per day.

Ms Bottomley would be required to be put on notice 14 days prior to the commencement of your matter.

If Ms Bottomley is required to attend in person, there is an additional \$400 for travel each way. There are no additional travel costs for being cross examined electronically.

In order to minimise disruption to Ms Bottomley's diary we require that we be advised as soon as possible should the matter not proceed. Additionally, should Ms Bottomley be called then we need at least a half days' notice for appearance on the same day but would ask for notice the day prior if the matter is being heard over more than one day.

When booking Ms Bottomley to attend Court to give evidence please identify how the parties intend to settle Ms Bottomley's invoice. We will issue the invoice for a half day upon replying to the notice to attend Court and ask that the parties then confirm they have their clients share of this in their trust account PRIOR TO MS BOTTOMLEY ATTENDING COURT. We then ask that payment is made the day of the Court appearance. Should Ms Bottomley end up not being cross examined, we will cancel the invoice at our end. If Ms Bottomley's attendance ends up carrying over to a full day, we will issue an invoice for the balance.
